The Associate Degree Nursing Program is accredited by the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN) and approved by the New Hampshire Board of Nursing (NBON). Upon satisfactory completion of the program, the graduate is eligible to apply to the New Hampshire Board of Nursing (NBON) and Pearson VUE NCLEX Candidate Services for the National Council Licensing Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN).

Admissions Requirements

Application must be **COMPLETED** by _____ to be considered for the Fall class.

1. Complete application to the program.
2. Provide proof of high school completion or equivalent.
3. Provide an official copy of prior college transcripts if seeking transfer credit.
4. Provide proof of completion of high school algebra, biology, and chemistry or equivalent with a grade of "C" or greater or proof of registration in a course with a projected date of completion only by June 30th of the current year.
5. Complete the All Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS[®]) with a total score of 63% or higher: GECC's All TEAS Testing Policy. Applicants are permitted to take the TEAS exam three times per 12-month period. Test dates must be at least 30 days apart. Test scores are valid for a period of two years. Scores may not be combined or averaged from multiple attempts. Test scores must be received by the application deadline.
