#### **ATI TEAS Exam**

- x Complete the ATI Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS)\* with a minimum Total Score of 66% or higher.
- x GBCC's TA TEAS Testing Policypplicants are permitted to take the TEAS exam three times period the period. Test dates must be at least 30 days aparest scores are valid for a period of two years must be received by the deadline.

- x are an active LPN, LNA/MNA, CNA, MA, Paramedic, o(SEMITM) a copy of your license/certification with your name and expiration date.)
- x are a current or former military medic/corpsmasubmit a copy of your DD Form 214 or Joint Services Transcript (JST) Community College of the Air Force (CCAF) transcript that shows your awarded military occupation.)
- x have completed a Medical Doctorate program (e.g. DMD, DVM, DDS, etc) (Submit a copy of license with your name and expiration date; if from outside the US, submit a copy of your transcript or diploma translated into English by a certified translation service if not originally in English.)
