Application Deadline: February 28th

Apply

- x Complete an application for the program; <https://www.greatbay.edu/admissions/apply/>

Transcripts

- x Provide:
 - o High School transcript or equivalent (GED/HiSet scores)
 - o Official college transcript(s) if applicable for transfer credit evaluation

ABCs (high school level or equivalent)

- x Must have completed with a "C" or better
 - o Algebra
 - o Biology
 - o Chemistry

ATI TEAS Exam

- x Complete the ATI Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS)* with a minimum Total Score of 66% or higher.
- x GBCC's ATI TEAS Testing Policy: Applicants are permitted to take the TEAS exam three times per 12-month period. Test dates must be at least 30 days apart. Test scores are valid for a period of two years. Scores must be received by the deadline.

*The ATI TEAS Pre-Entrance Exam is designed to identify areas that may need strengthening before a prospective student begins the major course of study in Nursing. Special consideration points are given to applicants who:

- x have completed college-level Human Anatomy Physiology I and/or II prior to February 28th deadline with a grade of "C+" within the past 5 years from the time of acceptance.
- x are a current or former Health Occupation student from a CTE high school program prior to the February 28th deadline.
- x are an active LPN, LNA/MNA, CNA, MA, Paramedic, or (SMT) (Submit a copy of your license/certification with your name and expiration date.)
- x are a current or former military medic/corpsman (Submit a copy of your DD Form 214 or Joint Services Transcript (JST) or Community College of the Air Force (CCAF) transcript that shows your awarded military occupation.)
- x have completed a Medical Doctorate program (e.g. DMD, DVM, DDS, etc) (Submit a copy of license with your name and expiration date; if from outside the US, submit a copy of your transcript or diploma translated into English by a certified translation service if not originally in English.)
